IFIO Basic Training

...is an experiential model of couples therapy that draws primarily from the Internal Family Systems (IFS) model of psychotherapy, but includes aspects of psychodynamic therapy, systems thinking, neuroscience and mindfulness practices. This model was born out of a desire to carry the concepts of IFS into a relational setting and to use the intimate relationship itself as a vehicle for growth and healing of the individual, as well as the couple. This 72-hour clinical training helps therapists enhance their knowledge and skills, facilitating relational work with couples and with individuals. Learn to work successfully with common difficulties in couples therapy. In this training, IFS therapists become skilled at working with the extreme impulses of protective parts, facilitating interpersonal and intrapsychic work, and assisting couples to communicate well and deepen heartfelt connection.

Toni Herbine-Blank MSN, RN (she/her) is the founder and creator of the Intimacy from the Inside Out (IFIO) model which is rooted in her expertise of the use of the Internal Family Systems (IFS) with couples. The (4) weekend modules will be led by Toni with skilled and talented BIPOC, Non-White and White bodied staff.

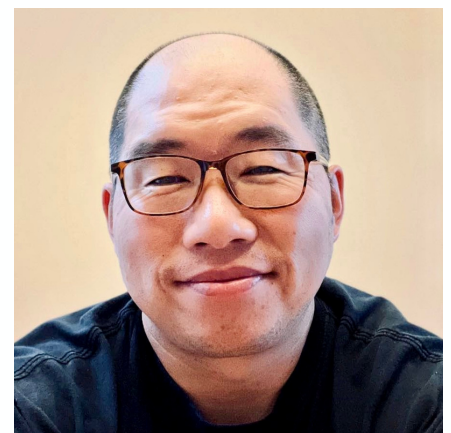
