Training overview

In addition to thoroughly learning IFS theory and technique, the Internal Family Systems Level 1 training programme invites participants to explore their own inner worlds in a safe, nurturing context. The training will help participants:

- Understand the conceptual base of the IFS model;
- Apply basic IFS techniques to various clinical populations; and
- Take advantage of the opportunities IFS offers for personal development.

The training includes lecture, discussion, demonstration, video review, experiential exercise, and small group supervision and practice. A more detailed curriculum can be provided on request. Each training will include previously trained participants to support training and small group work. There are no required written assignments for this training.

Dates

6-10 May, 8-12 July and 16-20 September. All dates in 2021.

Duration

15 days (participants need to attend a minimum of 90 hours from the total 108 training hours to receive a CPD certificate).

Size of group

33 (max) participants + 11 (max) Program Assistants in a ratio of 3:1.

9.30am to 5.30pm each day (start at 10.30am and finish at 4.30pm on the first and last day of each module).

Tuition cost

- **Before 2nd October 2020:** Early bird price, if fully paid by 1st October 2020, is £2800.

Not included in price. The Penny Brohn Centre is a lovely, quiet and peaceful residential venue with four acres of beautiful gardens. It is the headquarters of The Penny Brohn Cancer Care Charity. It has 26 double-bedded en-suite bedrooms. Accommodation is available on a first come first served basis at £60 per night (including VAT)*. Breakfast is included in the price. Please note that it is unlikely that rooms will be available the evening before the training. Room sharing is available at £35 per person per night (including VAT)*. Tea/coffee/nuts and fruit will be available at no further cost throughout each day. A light lunch of soup and salad is also included in the price.
