He is a Lead Trainer in the IFS Model and has presented on IFS at state, national and international conferences and teaches graduate courses on IFS. Ralph has a private practice in West Hartford, Connecticut, providing IFS-based therapy for individuals, couples, and families. He has an approachable and warm style of teaching and is committed to fostering a safe environment in which participants can connect with their core Selves.



Ann Sinko, LMFT has been a creative therapist for over 30 years. She is a senior IFS trainer and has integrated the IFS Model into all facets of her work with families, couples, individuals and groups. Ann is a natural teacher. She brings a down to earth, concrete style along with a sense of humor to her teaching. Currently, she uses her gifts to teach IFS, (level 1 and 2), and workshops. Ann has been adjunct faculty in the Marriage and Family therapy program at Central CT State University since 1995 and is in private practice in Portland, CT. Registration and Fees: The cost of the IFS training is \$3,800. Payment plans are available to pay in installments over the training period. A limited number of graduate student and alumni slots at a reduced fee of \$2,500 are available with student ID. Discounts of 15% are also available (3 or more). Please note: Tuition is set for the training program as a whole, not for individual days or weekends. Once registered, participants are responsible for **full payment** for the training program.

Space is limited to 36 participants. Applications will be evaluated as they are received. **Slots are filled on a first-come, first served basis.** After the slots are filled, names will be placed on a waiting list in the order that their application was received. Once the program has started, those on the waiting list will be refunded their deposits. **The program reserves the right to hold a limited number of slots for faculty and other special cases.** This training is for professionals in the Human Services fields and is a non-credit continuing education program.
